But this year, for various reasons, that program was not in operation so the holidays looked bleak. Fortunately, Putnam County Aging Program stepped in with the launch of a new Senior Christmas Gift Drive. The agency reached out to area groups to see if they would have interest in partnering to be sponsors for some of the areas aged and disabled. The request was met with wonderful support!

In addition to items donated by agency staff and seniors that participate in our John Henson and Buffalo Senior Center, the partnership included AllMed, CAMC Teays Valley, River Ridge Church in Hurricane, Teays Valley Physical Therapy and the WV State Police. Through such, the training room at the agency was filled with food and gifts for distribution to seniors and disabled persons letting them know they are loved and cared for and appreciated. A total of 67 people were sponsored through this effort this year and there is hope that it will grow even bigger in the years to come. Their gifts included anything from clothing, to food, paper products, cleaning supplies, books, puzzles and more.
