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Caring for the Caregiver Workshop

Family and professional caregivers alike invited for workshop at local senior centers

SAINT ALBANS, WV – July 22, 2016 – Putnam County Aging Program will be hosting four sessions of ‘Care for the Caregiver’, workshops for caregivers. The class will cover caregiving basics including expert tips that make caregiving safer and easier, information on planning ahead so caregivers can have control even in a crisis, and will inform participants about community resources available to caregivers.

Each workshop consists of four one hour sessions held for 4 consecutive weeks.

The first set of workshops will be held at the John Henson Senior Center in Hurricane, WV beginning August 2nd from 10 am – 11 am. The workshop will then run each Tuesday at the same time until August 23rd.

The second set of workshops will be held at the Hometown Senior Center starting August 17th from 10 am to 11 am, and held every Wednesday until September 7th.

The third set of workshops will be held at the Buffalo Senior Center, starting August 30th from 9 am – 10 am and being held every Tuesday until September 20th.
